Pre-Fed Jitters Drive Global Market Decline, Indian Markets Tumble as Rupee breaches past 90

Wall Street's main indexes fell on Monday, with most S&P 500 sectors declining and Treasury yields rising as investors awaited Wednesday's Federal Reserve policy decision.

Traders are pricing in 89% probability of a 25-basis-point rate cut. While the cut is widely expected, markets will focus on the Fed's statement for signals about 2026 rate policy.

The Fed will release its policy statement, updated economic projections, and Chair Jerome Powell will hold a press conference. Investors expect 2–4 additional cuts in 2026 unless economic data shifts significantly.

Treasury selling pushed the 30-year yield to a three-month high.

This week's central bank decisions begin Tuesday with the Reserve Bank of Australia, followed by Canada, Brazil, and Switzerland, culminating in the Fed announcement on Wednesday.

The United States will allow Nvidia's H200 processors, its second-best artificial intelligence chips, to be exported to China and collect a 25% fee on such sales.

Rising Japanese government bond yields sparked fears of a partial unwind of the yen carry trade, while a stronger dollar ahead of the Fed meeting kept foreign investors cautious. Nifty dropped over 200 points yesterday in a broad-based sell-off.

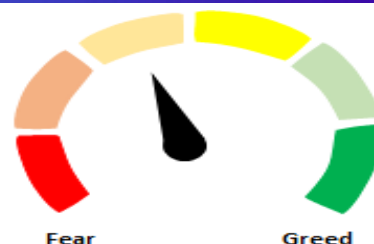
The rupee breached 90 per dollar as foreign portfolio investors remained net sellers in recent sessions, fueling volatility and profit-taking in Indian equities.

The broader market suffered sharper losses.

Market breadth remained weak for a seventh straight session. The Nifty Midcap 100 fell 1.83%, while the Nifty Small Cap 100 plunged 2.61%—its steepest single-day drop since April 7, 2025, and a six-month low.

By closing below its prior swing low of 25,986, Nifty confirmed a lower bottom following a lower top, reinforcing the short-term corrective structure. A decisive break below 25,891 would likely accelerate selling and expose support zones of the 50-day exponential moving average at 25,722.

Indian markets are poised to open subdued on the back of weak global cues.

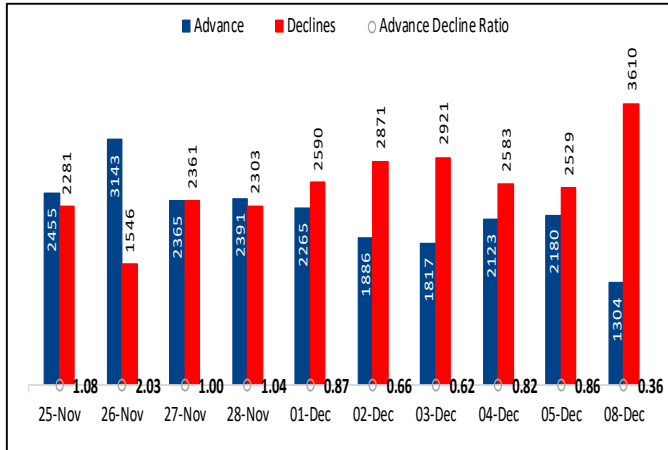

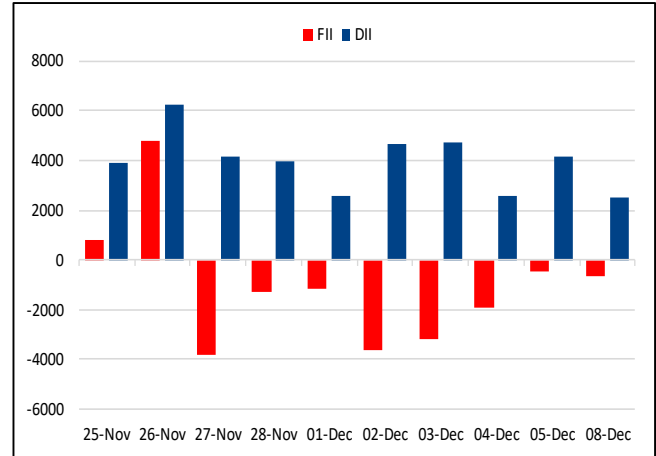

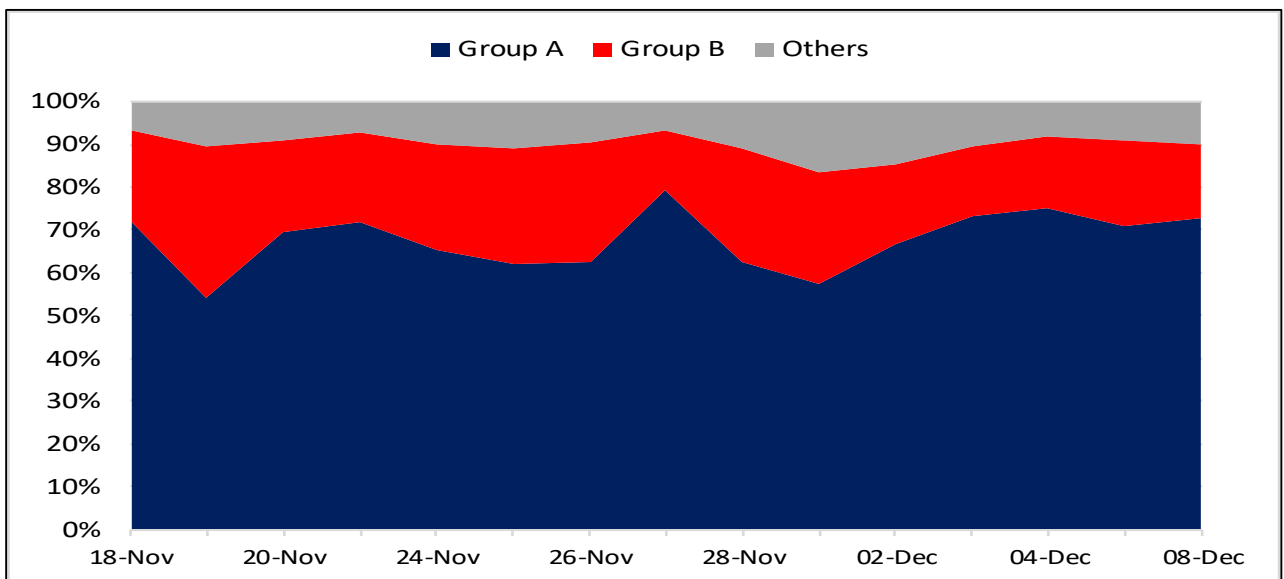

Key Events

Australia business conditions soften in November, capacity constrained

A measure of Australian business conditions pulled back in November as sales and profits both eased after a couple of strong months, a survey showed, while many firms still reported limited spare capacity.

The survey from National Australia Bank showed its index of business conditions fell 3 points to +7 in November, coming off its highest level since March 2024. The survey's volatile measure of business confidence slid 5 points to +1. The result could point to some cooling in consumer demand after a very strong October, though the lack of spare capacity fits with recent high readings on inflation.

UK consumer spending disappointed in November, surveys show

British consumers kept a tight rein on their spending in November as they awaited finance minister Rachel Reeves' budget, while retailers said Black Friday sales disappointed, according to surveys.

Barclays said spending on its credit and debit cards fell by 1.1% in annual terms in November, the biggest drop since February 2021 when the COVID-19 pandemic still raged.

A separate survey from the British Retail Consortium (BRC) trade body showed spending at big retailers rose by 1.4% in annual terms last month, the slowest growth since May.

The surveys chimed with other indicators showing a weakening consumer economy. Official data showed retail sales fell sharply in October and the Confederation of British Industry said confidence among chains of stores hit a 17-year low last month.

China funnelled \$80 billion into overseas cleantech in past year, report says

Chinese firms have committed some \$80 billion in clean technology investments overseas over the past year as they sought new markets to absorb a supply glut, according to a report by Australian research group Climate Energy Finance (CEF).

Many countries also deepened their cleantech cooperation with China in the wake of U.S. President Donald Trump's tariffs, according to the report released on Sunday, bringing China's total overseas direct investments in green technology to more than \$180 billion since the start of 2023.

German corporate bankruptcies to surge to a decade high in 2025

German corporate insolvencies are projected to hit their highest level in more than a decade this year, a new study revealed, as the nation grapples with a stubborn economic downturn.

Approximately 23,900 companies are expected to file for bankruptcy in 2025, an 8.3% increase from 2024 and the highest figure since 2014, according to a report by credit agency Creditreform.

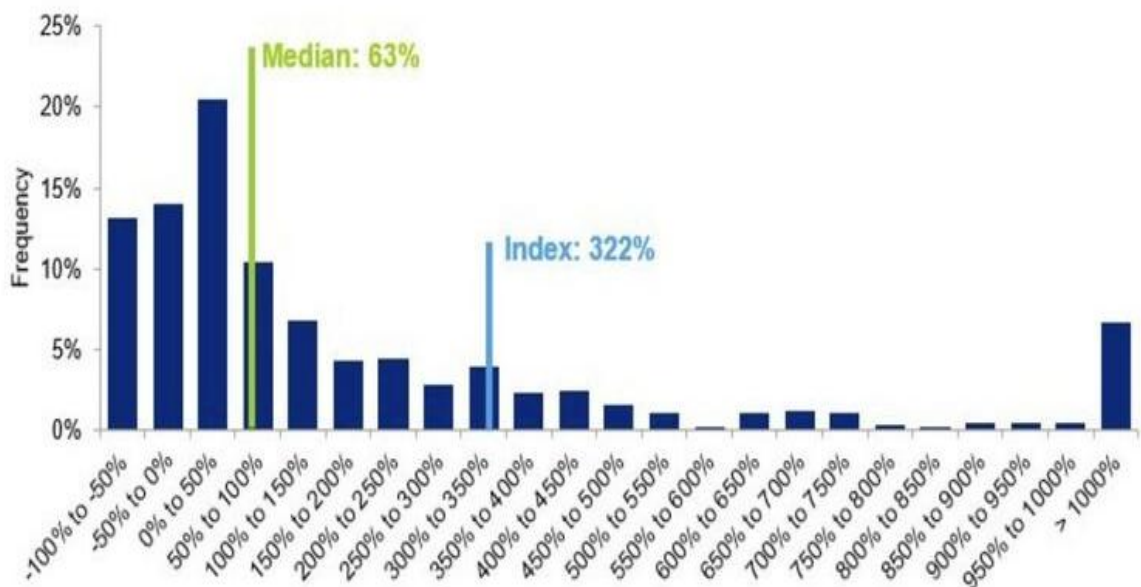
While that growth would be slower than in previous years, the rising numbers underscore deep-seated challenges facing German businesses following two years of economic contraction.

Chart with Interesting Observations

Beating the Benchmark You Built: Only 22% Outperforms the Index

- The conventional wisdom suggesting that active stock picking within the stock market is a reliable strategy for outperformance is demonstrably challenged by two decades of market data.
- From the turn of the millennium through 2020, a striking disparity emerged: a mere 22% of the constituent stocks managed to surpass the return of the composite index itself. This means that nearly four-fifths of the firms—the very companies that define and contribute to the S&P 500's overall performance—actually lagged behind the benchmark they collectively established.
- This presents a potent paradox, fundamentally questioning the efficacy of trying to the select few high-performers, as the overwhelming majority are destined for sub-par returns relative to the aggregate.

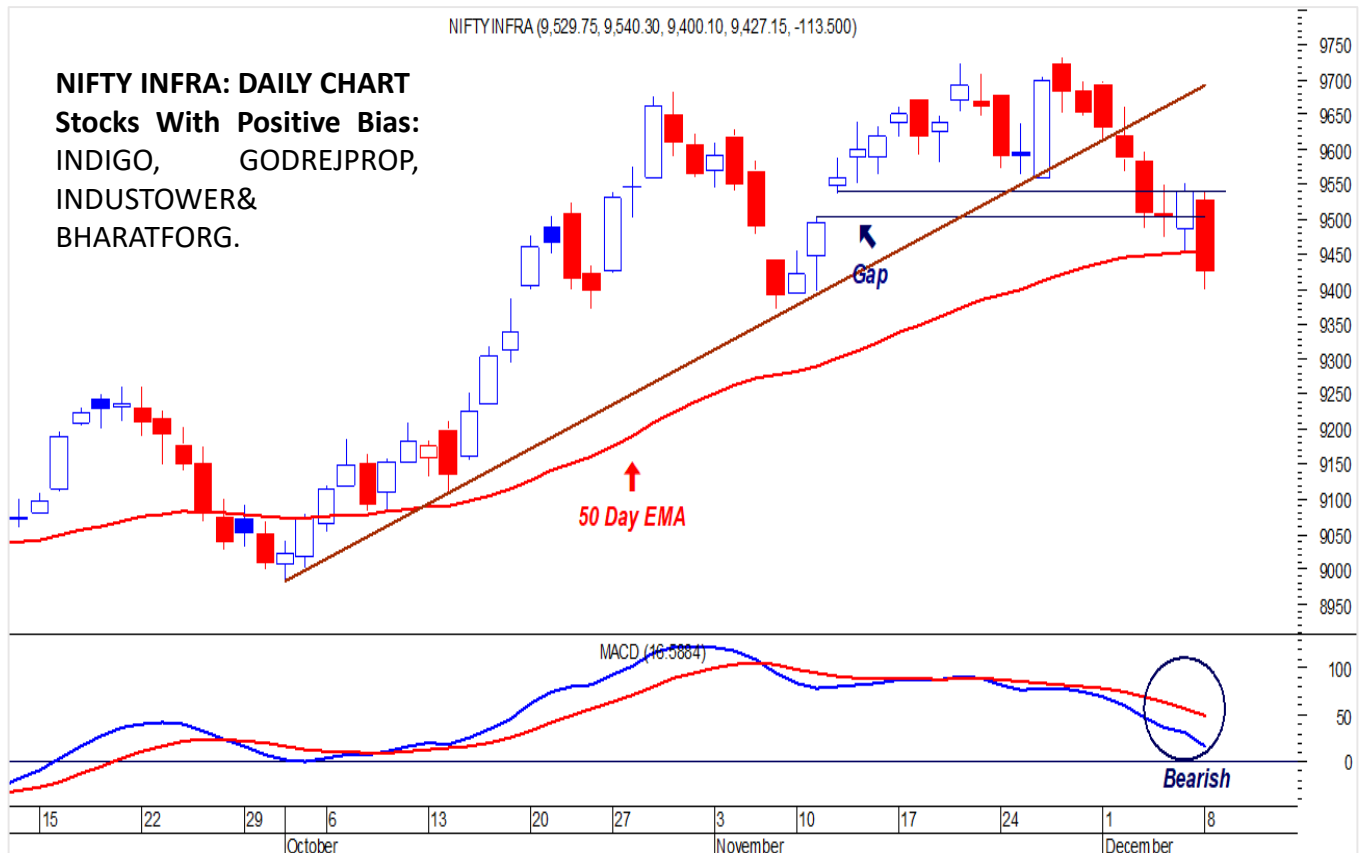
Most S&P 500 Constituents Underperform the Index (Data from 2000 to 2020)

SHORT BUILD UP WAS SEEN IN NIFTY & BANKNIFTY FUTURES

- The Nifty's attempt at a follow-up rally failed, as the index fell 97 points to close at 24487. After an initial rise in the first hour of trade to 24702, the Nifty reversed direction and fell over 200 points from its high, settling near the day's low.
- Short Build-Up was seen in the Nifty Futures where Open Interest rose by 8.45% with Nifty falling by 0.86%.
- Short Build-Up was seen in the Bank Nifty Futures where Open Interest rose by 18.32% with Bank Nifty falling by 0.90%.
- Nifty Open Interest Put Call ratio fell to 0.64 levels from 1.21 levels. PCR was near oversold territory.
- Amongst the Nifty options (09-Dec Expiry), Call writing is seen at 26000-26100 levels, indicating Nifty is likely to find strong resistance in the vicinity of 26000-26100 levels. On the lower side, an immediate support is placed in the vicinity of 25900-25800 levels where we have seen Put writing.
- Short build-up was seen by FII's in the Index Futures segment where they net sold worth 3,442 cr with their Open Interest going up by 15325 contracts.

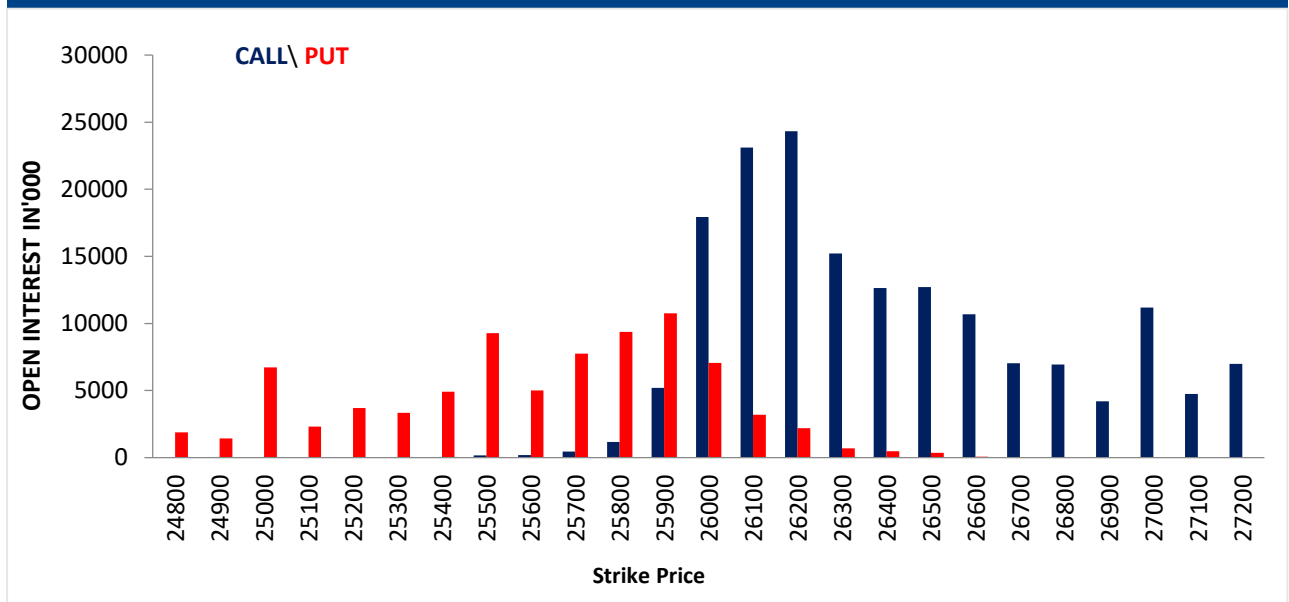
