U.S. Markets Rally After Agreement with Iran to End the War

U.S. equities rose on Monday after President Donald Trump announced that an agreement had been reached to end the war between the U.S. and Iran.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average gained 0.92% to hit a new all time high, while the S&P 500 climbed 1.66% and the NASDAQ Composite jumped 3.07%. The tech heavy Nasdaq recorded its best day since March 31.

SpaceX shares gained nearly 20% after their 19% surge in the company's public-market debut on Friday.

The CBOE Volatility Index, which measures implied volatility of S&P 500 options, fell 8.37% to 16.20, signalling a sharp drop in market uncertainty.

Crude oil prices plunged: WTI July futures fell more than 4% to \$81 per barrel, and Brent declined about 4% to \$83.50. Gold futures for August delivery were up over 2%, to close around \$4,350 per troy ounce.

Asian markets are trading mixed today after a sharp rally in the prior session on news of the U.S.–Iran peace deal, as investors refocused on several central bank decisions, including a widely expected rate move from the Bank of Japan.

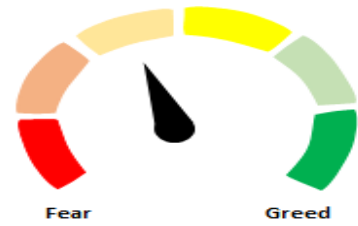
Back home, Nifty extended gains for a second consecutive session on Monday, rising 231 points to close at 23,853.

The Indian rupee appreciated by 40 paise, supported by easing geopolitical tensions that led to a decline in crude oil prices and the US dollar. Additionally, sustained dollar inflows into the debt market—driven by recent government and RBI measures—along with improving global risk appetite, provided further support to the domestic currency.

Foreign institutional investors turned net buyers in cash equities for the first time this month while In the Index futures segment their short covering /long build up continued.

Despite the intraday pullback of nearly 200 points from the day's high, Nifty held above its 50-day DEMA, positioned near 23,772, which was decisively surpassed during the gap-up opening yesterday. This indicates that the short-term bias remains positive. On the upside, immediate resistance is seen near the 24,100 level, while the 23,600–23,700 zone is expected to provide near-term support.

After two days of sharp rise, Indian markets are set to open flat amid mixed Asian market cues.

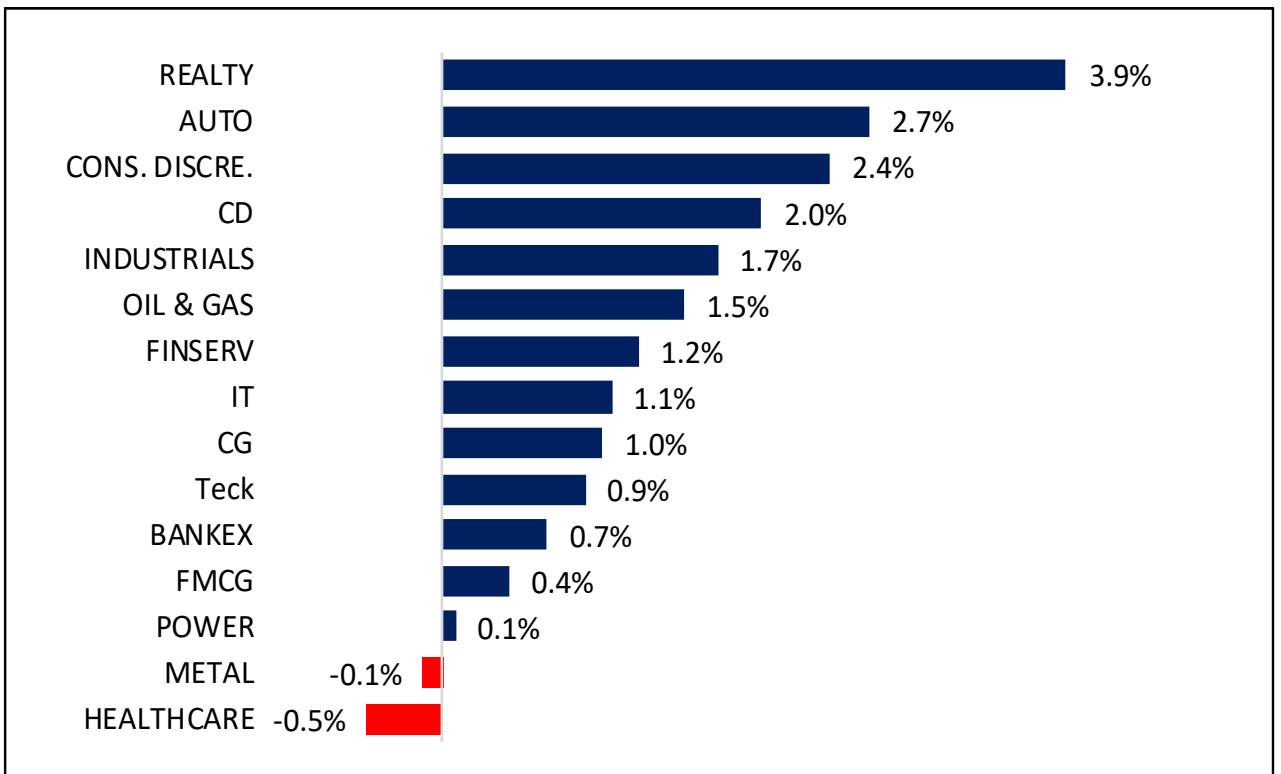

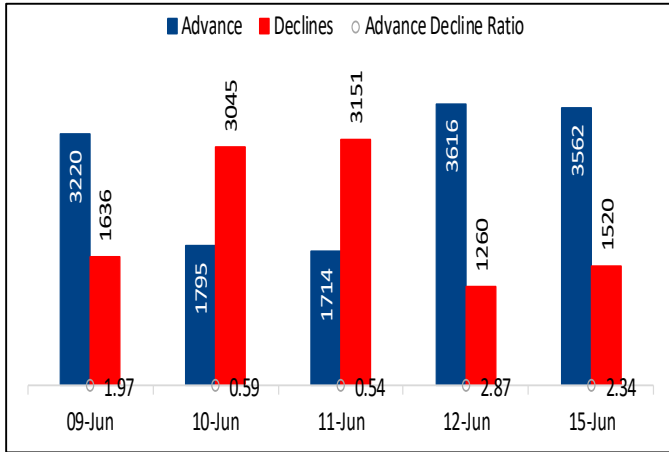

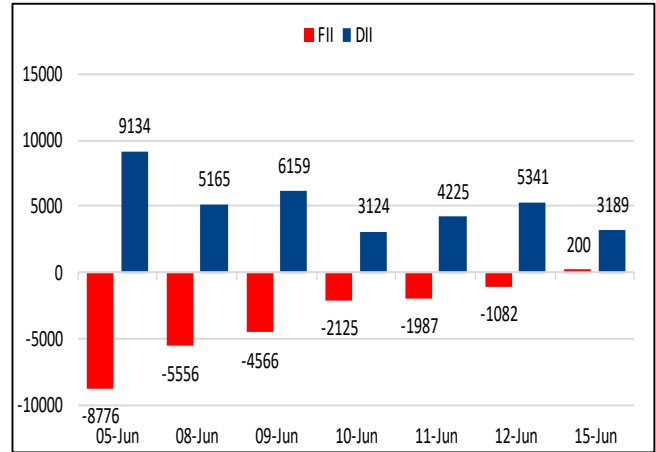

Institutional Activities (Rs Cr)



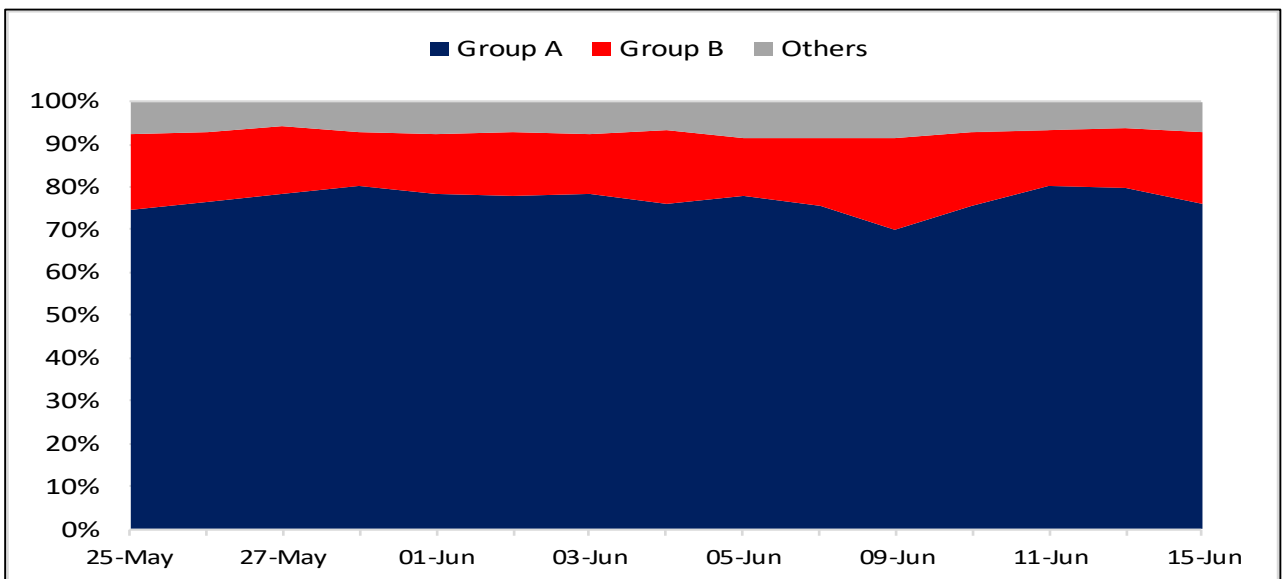

Key Events

US factory production flat in May; AI investment supporting manufacturing

U.S. factory production was unexpectedly unchanged in May after gains in the prior months, which some economists said were related to businesses building up inventory in anticipation of shortages and higher prices due to the war in the Middle East. Manufacturing output increased by an upwardly revised 0.7% in April. Production rose 0.2% in March after accelerating 0.7% in February.

Industrial production growth slows, missing forecasts

Industrial production in the United States has shown signs of deceleration, according to the latest data released. The report indicates that the growth in industrial production was recorded at 0.1%. This figure falls short of the anticipated forecast of 0.3%, signaling a slowdown in the sector's growth rate.

China industrial production rises slightly above expectations in May

Chinese industrial production grew slightly more than expected in May, as local factories continued to benefit from outsized overseas demand despite growing economic headwinds. Industrial production rose 4.5% year-on-year in May, more than expectations of 4.4%, government data showed on Tuesday. The print also accelerated from the 4.1% increase in the prior month.

India May trade gap narrows as exports offset elevated energy import bill

India's merchandise trade deficit narrowed marginally to \$28.21 billion in May as high global energy prices boosted petroleum exports, partly offsetting elevated import bill. Merchandise exports rose to \$45.2 billion in May from \$43.56 billion in the previous month, while imports rose to \$73.41 billion against a six-month high of \$71.94 billion in April.

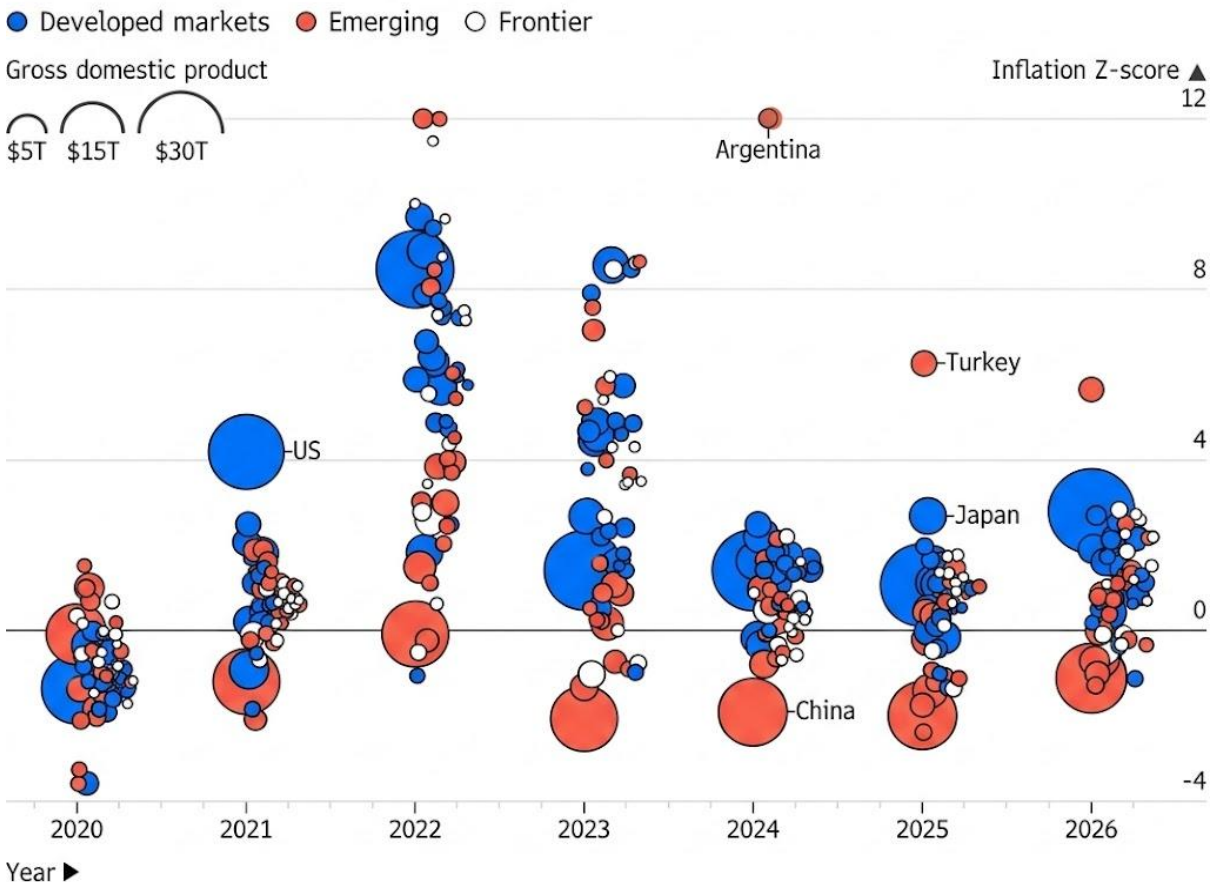

Global Inflation Heats Up Again in 2026

- Global inflation is experiencing a synchronised resurgence in 2026 after a brief cooling period in 2024 and 2025. The distance of each market's annual inflation rate from its 2010–2019 historical average using standard deviation Z-scores reveals that a substantial cluster of developed, emerging, and frontier economies are swinging sharply back into positive territory. While major economies like China managed to stay well below their historical averages in recent years, the broader momentum into mid-2026 indicates that price pressures are heating up again globally, moving multiple nations significantly above the baseline zero-line.

Distance of each market's annual inflation rate from its 2010-2019 average



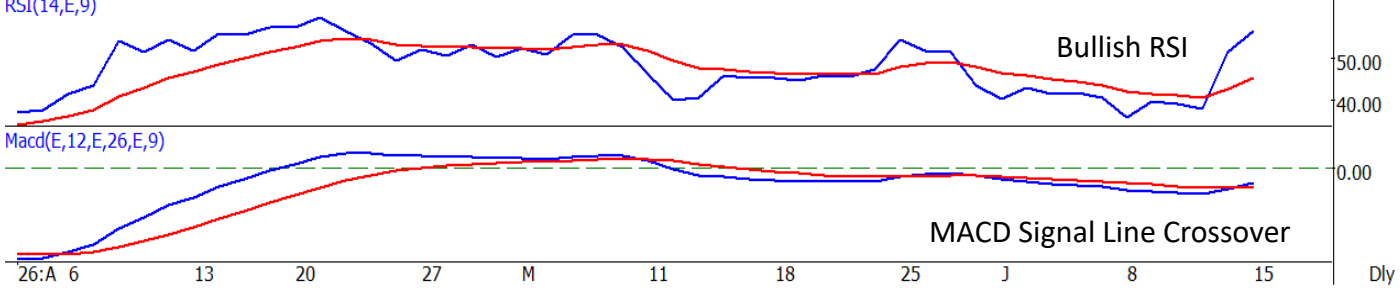

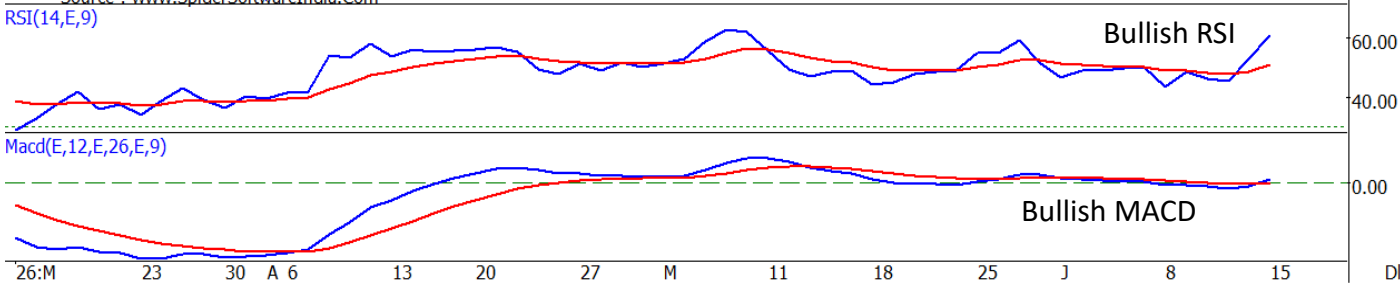
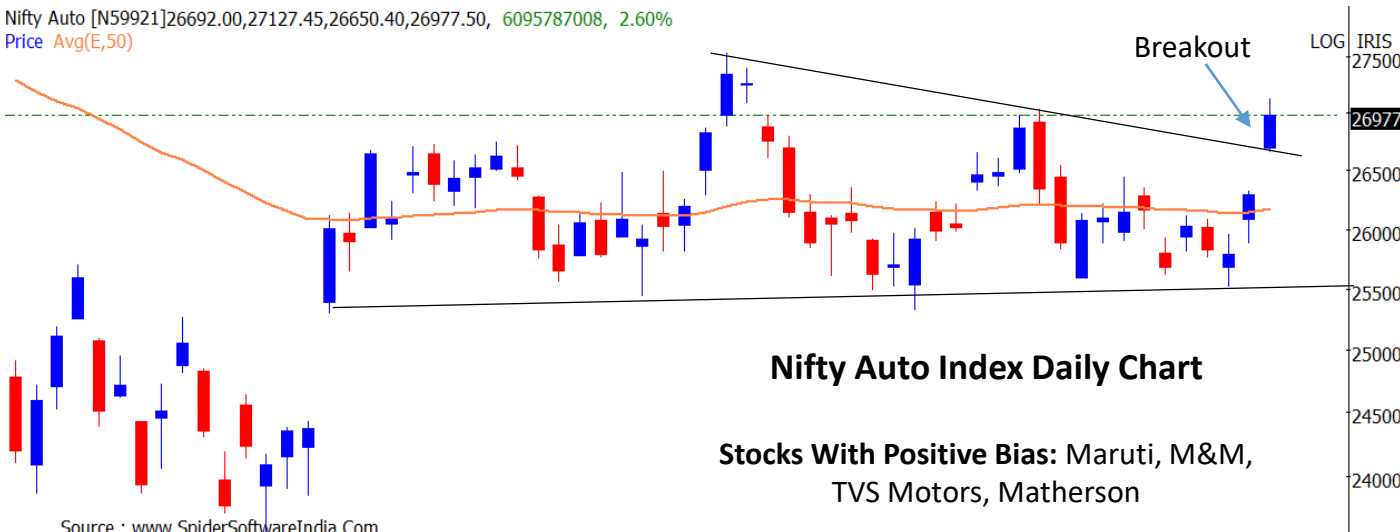

CALL WRITING WAS SEEN AT 23900 – 24000 LEVELS

- Nifty extended its rally for a second straight session, gaining 231 points to close at 23,853. The index opened sharply higher on positive global cues and lower crude oil prices but pared part of its gains later amid profit booking.
- Short Covering was seen in the Nifty Futures where Open Interest fell by 1.25% with Nifty rising by 0.98%.
- Short Covering was seen in the Bank Nifty Futures where Open Interest fell by 3.23% with Bank Nifty rising by 0.68%.
- Nifty Open Interest Put Call ratio fell to 0.99 levels from 1.41 levels.
- Amongst the Nifty options (16-Jun Expiry), Call writing is seen at 23900-24000 levels, indicating Nifty is likely to find strong resistance in the vicinity of 23900-24000 levels. On the lower side, an immediate support is placed in the vicinity of 23800-23700 levels where we have seen Put writing.
- Short covering was seen by FII's' in the Index Futures segment where they net bought worth 329 cr with their Open Interest going down by 176 contracts.

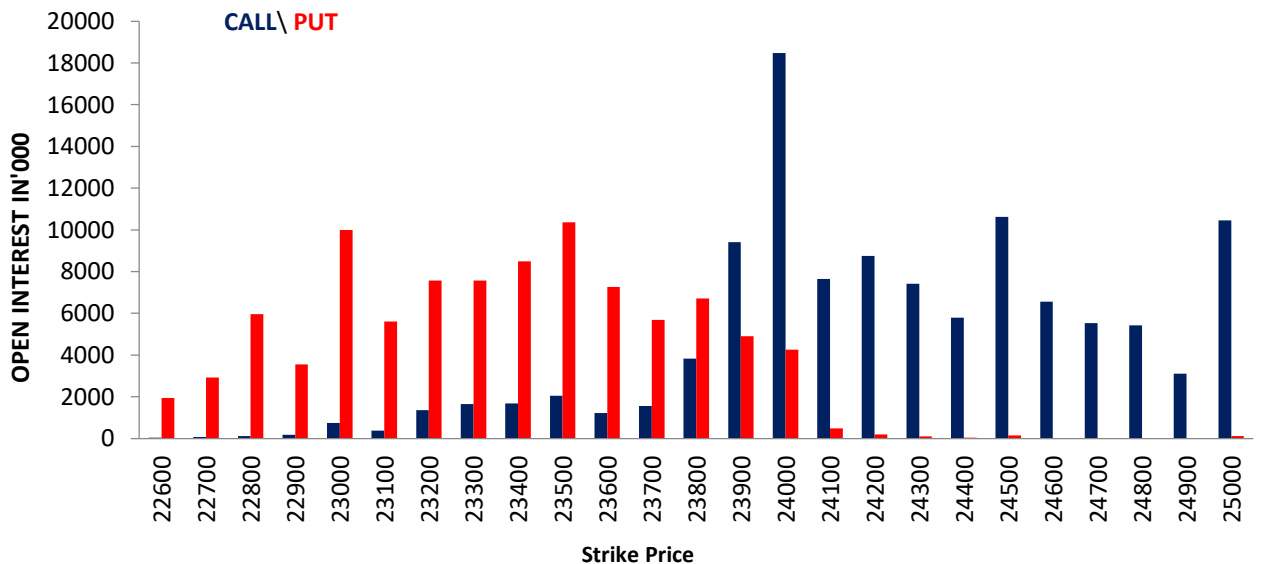
