## Indian Markets Eye Recovery as Global Sentiment Stabilises

Friday brought welcome relief to major US indices, fuelled by renewed speculation that the Federal Reserve may cut rates in December after dovish remarks from policymakers.

Technology and communication services lagged amid profit-taking that hit AI and cloud leaders, despite strong earnings from Nvidia and Amazon.

Homebuilding stocks rallied sharply on rate optimism, while discount retailers such as Ross Stores surged on strong earnings.

Defensive sectors like consumer staples held up better, cushioning overall losses. The VIX remained elevated in the low-20s as investors weighed Fed easing hopes against growth, tariffs, and labour-market uncertainties.

Back home, the rupee hit an all-time low of 89.67 against the dollar, pressured by subdued risk sentiment, global uncertainties, and delays in the US-India trade deal.

Indian markets drew support from the RBI's export relief measures, though sentiment was dampened by October's widening trade deficit and sharp export contraction. PMI data showed continued expansion despite moderating manufacturing momentum.

Healthy Q2 earnings, robust macro indicators, and reviving FPI inflows—aided by easing inflation and stable crude prices—provided a liquidity cushion for large caps.

Broader markets underperformed.

Nifty fell sharply on Friday, though it remains above its nearest moving average support at 26038. Below 26038, the recent swing low at 25856 is expected to act as a crucial support level, while 26277 remains short-term resistance.

Indian markets have demonstrated resilience in weathering recent setbacks and now appear poised to challenge previous peaks.

**Markets are likely to open buoyantly and attempt to break out of the recent consolidation phase today.**

The Project will be implemented through a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV), with DGPC and Tata Power holding equity shares of 60% and 40%, respectively. Tata Power has committed an equity investment of approximately Rs 1,572 crore to be infused in tranches. The project is slated for commissioning in September 2031, and 80% of its generation will be supplied to India

## Key Events

### **Services PMI beats estimates, indicating stronger US economic activity**

The Services Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI), a key indicator of economic health in the service sector, has outperformed expectations in its latest release. The actual figure came in at 55.0, exceeding the forecasted number of 54.6.

The Services PMI data, published monthly by Markit Economics, is based on surveys of over 400 executives in private sector service companies. The surveys cover industries such as transport and communication, financial intermediaries, business and personal services, computing & IT, hotels and restaurants. An index level above 50 signals an improvement from the previous month, and the recent 55.0 reading indicates a robust expansion in the service sector.

### **Trump tariff relief leaves 22% of Brazil's shipments still hit**

Brazil's government said that 22% of its exports to the United States remain subject to a 40% extra tariff after President Donald Trump expanded the list of exemptions to include goods such as coffee, meat and fruit.

Those products are also hit by the U.S. base tariff of 10%, the Ministry of Development, Industry, Trade and Services said, citing 2024 export values.

Speaking to reporters, Vice President Geraldo Alckmin said that before Washington's decision on Thursday, the share of products facing the full 50% tariff had stood at 36%.

### **Moody's affirms UK's Aa3 rating ahead of budget**

Global ratings agency Moody's affirmed the United Kingdom's Aa3 rating, citing the significant credit strength of the world's sixth-biggest economy and the government's commitment to reducing the large budget deficit.

The agency maintained the country's outlook at "stable".

"The rating affirmation incorporates expectation of fiscal measures consistent with the government-defined fiscal rules in the upcoming 2026 budget due to be presented on 26 November, which will help to keep the cost of debt moderate," Moody's said.

Finance minister Rachel Reeves, in her second annual budget, is expected by economists to raise taxes by 20 billion to 30 billion pounds to keep her budget goals on track.

### **Swiss regulator warns mortgage risks are rising as banks stretch lending rules**

Switzerland's financial market regulator warned of growing risks in the housing market, saying banks were stretching mortgage lending criteria as property prices continue to climb.

"The risk in the mortgage market is high, prices continue to rise, and the danger of a correction is correspondingly high," the head of FINMA, Stefan Walter, told the Swiss news outlet Blick in an interview.
